

VOCABULARY STATION

You will be at this station each week we have vocabulary and a Treasures story. You can work with a partner but each of you have to turn in a paper. Some weeks may require more than one day at the station.

Step 1. Using the week's pre-story, write each highlighted word and leave 6 lines between each word.

Step 2. Write at the top of the paper the name of the week's story.

Step 3. Beneath the title, write the numbers of this week's assignments. For example,
The Case of the Phantom Poet
2,4,6,7,8

For each vocabulary word, you will complete the tasks assigned for the week. What follows is the numbered list of possible tasks.

1. Write the glossary definition for the word (blue)

2.. Write a definition for the word in your own words(orange)

3. Write a sentence of your own that includes the vocabulary word
(green)

4. Draw a picture that shows the meaning of the word

5. Write the word in the context of the sentence from the story(red)

6. Using a dictionary, write out the phonetic spelling(pink)

7. Using a dictionary, write out how the word is divided by syllables
(purple)

8. Using a dictionary, write other meanings for the word (brown)

9. Write at least 2 synonyms for the word (yellow)

10. Write at least 2 antonyms for the word (light blue) -

11. Identify what part of speech the word is: noun, verb, adjective, adverb
(light green)

12. Using a dictionary, write other forms of the word
(turquoise)

13. Using a dictionary, write from what language or country the word comes
(lavender)
